

AN ACT

To amend an act entitled "Enacting a charter for the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon, and repealing any and all former charters or amendments thereto of the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon," adopted by the people of the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon, at an election held August 24, 1942, by amending Section 35 to permit the waiver of the requirement that ordinances be read in full and distinctly.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "Enacting a charter for the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon, and repealing any and all former charters or amendments thereto of the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon," adopted by the people of the City of Troutdale, Oregon, at an election held August 24, 1942, be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 35 to read as follows:

SECTION 35. INTRODUCTION, READING, AND PASSAGE. Every ordinance shall be fully and distinctly read in open council meeting on two (2) different days previous to the date put upon its final passage, but any ordinance may be introduced, read twice, once in full and once by title, and put on its final passage at a single meeting by the unanimous vote of all members of the council present at the meeting except an ordinance providing for the appropriation of money other than for the payment of current running expenses of the city. By unanimous consent of the council members present, the reading of the ordinance in full and distinctly may be waived. Upon the final vote the ayes and nays of the council shall be taken and recorded in the journal. If the ordinance passes the recorder shall so indorse it with the date and his name and title of office, and the mayor shall, within three (3) days thereafter, sign the ordinance with the date, his name, and the title of his office.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts adopted by vote of the people of the City of Troutdale, Oregon, in conflict with this act are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance for the proposed charter amendment submitted to the voters by the Council be filed with the Recorder of the City of Troutdale, Oregon, for submission to the legal voters of said city for their rejection or approval, to be voted on at the general election to be held on November 7, 1972.


SECTION 4. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the Public health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Troutdale in the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale and its signing by the Mayor.
