

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 189 RELATING TO METER INSTALLATION CHARGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 189 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Service Connection Charge.

7.3 Standard meter installation as follows:

<u>Service Size</u>	<u>Material and Labor Cost</u>	<u>Improvement Fee</u>	<u>Total Charge</u>
3/4"	\$ 135.00	\$ 300.00	\$ 435.00
1"	175.00	420.00	595.00

All installations 1½ inch and larger at cost of labor and material plus 20 per cent, plus system improvement fee as follows:

<u>Service Size</u>	<u>System Improvement Fee</u>
1½"	\$ 860.00
2"	1,360.00
3"	2,740.00
4"	4,800.00
6"	10,660.00

A system improvement fee will not apply to fire stand-by detector check meters.

7.3a Multiple Dwelling Units.

1. The amount stated in the existing water rate schedule for the particular meter size.
or if greater,

2. The cost of meter installation including labor and materials, plus 20 per cent of labor and materials, plus a system improvement fee equal to \$ 150.00 times the number of living units. (For apartments, hotels, mobil parks, and motels complexes this would be \$ 150.00 times the number of units available for rental and for a mobil home park this would be \$ 150.00 times the number of spaces for mobil homes.)

all over 11,250 gallons	\$ 0.25 per 750 gallons

9.3 Standby Service Connection Demand Charge.

<u>Size Meter</u>	<u>Minimum Monthly Charge</u>
3"	\$ 11.00
4"	13.00
6"	16.00
8"	25.00
10"	33.00
12"	40.00


