

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 206 REGULATING THE LICENSING OF BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, OREGON, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ISSUE BUSINESS LICENSES.


Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, that Section 10 of Ordinance Number 206 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 10. On or before the first day of January of each and every license year as herein provided, after passage of this ordinance, every person, as herein defined, engaged in business, as defined herein, in the City of Troutdale, Oregon, which said businesses are in this ordinance scheduled and designated, shall make application to the Mayor for a license to carry on business for the license year. The Mayor shall be responsible for approving or denying the license. All licenses approved by the Mayor shall be submitted to the City Council for ratification at the next Council meeting. In the event of disapproval, notice shall be given to the applicant of the disapproval by the Mayor. The applicant may appeal the disapproval by the Mayor to the City Council provided that the applicant give written notice to the City of his desire to appeal. The appeal will be presented to the City Council at its next regular meeting.


