

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 213 AND TERMINATING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE STREET LIGHTING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 213 is hereby repealed effective 11:59 p.m. June 30, 1977 and the Street Lighting Improvement District for the City of Troutdale, Multnomah County, State of Oregon created by Ordinance 213 shall terminate effective 11:59 p.m., June 30, 1977.

Section 2: The "STREET LIGHTING FUND" established by Ordinance 213 shall continue until terminated by Council. Funds received pursuant to Ordinance 213 subsequent to June 30, 1977 may be placed in the general fund or other fund as Council may determine.

Section 3: All unpaid charges and assessments made pursuant to Ordinance No. 213 shall remain due and owing and all liens arising as a result of unpaid charges and assessments shall continue until paid and this Ordinance shall have no affect thereon.
