AN ORDINANCE SPREADING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT KNOWN AS CHERRY PARK L.I.D. 1-76, A PARTIAL STORM AND FULL SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM.
