

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 220, SECTION 3, BY ADDING A PROVISION EXEMPTING FRANCHISES FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 220 has no clear provision for the award and management of franchises by the City of Troutdale; and,

WHEREAS, Oregon Administrative Rule 127-10.040 permits exemption from competitive bidding for those contracts for the purchase of goods or services where the rate or price for the goods or services being purchased is established by federal, state or local regulatory authority; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the City of Troutdale provide for the more expeditious, efficient and effective administration of certain public contracts through the aforementioned exemption; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1.

The following subsection will be added to Section 3 of Ordinance No. 220:

- (f) Contracts for the purchase of goods or services where the rate or price for the goods or services being purchased is established by federal, state or local regulatory authority.


SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.
