

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 217, REDUCING THE ASSESSMENTS FOR CERTAIN PROPERTIES AND AUTHORIZING REFUNDS AND RE-SPREADING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT KNOWN AS THE DRINKER WELL WATER SYSTEM LID 1-73,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Short Title: This Ordinance shall be known as the Drinker LID Reassessment Ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to reassess properties within the Drinker LID 1-73 to accurately reflect the local benefit of the improvements.

Section 3. Authority: This Ordinance is passed pursuant to the authority set forth in Ordinance No. 159 as amended and ORS Chapter 223. Notices to interested parties have been duly made and a hearing was held for all participants to present objections pursuant to Resolution No. 218.

Section 4 Reassessment: The Common Council finds that the total Drinker LID costs to be assessed as a local improvement should be reduced by 175,541.73.

The Common Council further finds that the reduction should be allocated in the same proportion as the original area wide assessment.

In accordance with the foregoing findings the Common Council hereby re-spreads the assessments as set forth on the attached "reassessment roll" so marked, attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Refunds: Wherever indicated, the Finance Director is authorized to make refunds to the person or persons who were originally assessed and said payments shall be made out of the Improvement Bond Fund.


Section 6. Assessment Collections: The Finance Director is directed to commence semi-annual billings on the 1st day of July, 1980, to all owners of property for which any assessment remains outstanding with accrued interest on original assessment through June 30, 1980.


