

ORDINANCE NO. 338-O

The Emergency Medical Service Ordinance.

WHEREAS, it is a portion of the City's responsibility to ensure that quality emergency medical service is available to the citizens of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, such controls on the quality of service are minimal; and

WHEREAS, the Staff of the City has been working with other government in the County to ensure such quality; and

WHEREAS, the joint effort of these governments is embodied in Multnomah County Ordinance No. 229.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

SECTION 1 Ordinance Title

This ordinance shall be known as the Emergency Medical Ordinance and shall apply within the jurisdictional limits of the City of Troutdale.

SECTION 2 Ordinance Body

- A. The City of Troutdale adopts the Multnomah County Emergency Medical Services Ordinance No. 229, as adopted on June 5, 1980, as the City's own ordinance.

B. The Mayor or his designated representative from the council body shall serve as representative to the Policy Board as describe in Section 6.31.035 (B) of said ordinance.
