

ORDINANCE NO. 363-O

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CODE SECTIONS PROHIBITING THE PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The following sections be adopted as part of the City of Troutdale Public Safety Code:

PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL


7.60.410 Consumption of Alcohol Prohibited. Except as otherwise provided in Section 7.40.150 City of Troutdale Public Safety Code no person shall drink or consume an alcoholic beverage in any public street, road, highway, sidewalk or parking lot or in any private driveway, road or parking lot which is extended to public use. An alcoholic beverage shall be defined as a beverage containing more than one half of one per cent of alcohol by volume.

7.60.415 Penalties. Violation of Section 7.60.410 is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250.00, or confinement in jail not to exceed 30 days or both.

Effect of Other Laws. This ordinance shall not affect the validity of enforceability of any other state law or county ordinance which is or may be in the future in effect and which relate to the activities regulated by this ordinance.


