AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE TROUTDALE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN INVENTORY AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. .

WHEREAS, Pursuant to ORS 271.120 a hearing was held on March 23, 1982, at which the Common Council made the following findings:

- 1. In the development of a Comprehensive Plan, the State Land Conservation and Development Commission requires that "ultimate land use choices" be made in respect of all land within a planning jurisdiction.
- 2. To meet this requirement, the City Council earlier adopted a new Policy Area VII (County Farm) as an interim measure to allow time to develop ultimate land use choices for this site.
- 3. The amendment as shown in the attached pages referred to as Exhibit "A", provides the basis for the change in the land use designation of the "County Farm" site.
- 4. Exhibit "A" has been reviewed and recommended by the Troutdale Planning Commission and commented on by CAC.
- 5. There has been opportunity for citizen review.
- 6. Exhibit "A" is consistent with remaining portions of the text.
- 7. The changes are in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

The Comprehensive Plan Inventory be revised as shown on the attached Exhibit "A".
