AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 271 PROVIDING CHANGES IN THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO THE MOBILE HOME, SINGLE-FAMILY, AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLING DEFINITIONS.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 12.050 of the City Zoning Ordinance a public hearing was held on August 24, 1982 at which the Common Council made the following findings:

- 1. Revisions to the Comprehensive Plan will result in a thorough revision of all implementing ordinances.
- 2. Mobile homes are determined not to be a needed housing type in Troutdale.
- 3. Single-family and Two-family dwelling units constructed per the "Uniform Building Code" standards differ from mobile homes constructed per "Housing and Urban Development" standards.
- 4. Some confusion currently exist which creates a hardship on all those involved in the land development process.
- 5. The changes as shown in the attached pages, referred to as Exhibit "A", will resolve the aforementioned concerns and are consistent with the City's recently revised Comprehensive Plan.
- 6. Exhibit "A" has been reviewed by the Troutdale Planning Commission.
- 7. Exhibit "A" is consistent with the remaining portions of the Zoning Ordinance text.
- 8. There has been opportunity for citizen review and comment.
- 9. The changes are in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

The Zoning Ordinance text be changed as shown in the attached Exhibit "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

Section 3.025. Dwelling, Duplex or Two-family:

A building **(EXCLUDING MOBILE HOMES)** designed exclusively for occupancy by two (2) families living independently of each other.

Section 3.026. Dwelling, One-family or Single-family: A detached building (EXCLUDING MOBILE HOMES) designed for the occupancy by one (1) family.

Section 3.057. Mobile Home:

A-detached-single-family-dwelling-unit-with-the-following eharacteristics:

- a) A-factory-built-home-designed-to-be-transported-after fabrication-on-its-own-wheels-or-detachable-wheels.
- b) A--dwelling--unit--which--is--designed--for--long--term occupancy-once-the-mobile-home-is-installed-on-a-site.

A STRUCTURE CONSTRUCTED FOR MOVEMENT ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, THAT HAS SLEEPING, COOKING, AND PLUMBING FACILITIES, IS INTENDED FOR HUMAN OCCUPANCY AND IS BEING USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES.
