ORDINANCE NO. 405-0

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 362, PROVIDING CHANGES IN THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 12.050 of the City Zoning Ordinance, a public hearing was held in May 1983, at which the Common Council made the following findings:

- 1. There is concern about the adequacy of the overlay Historic Resource District to protect inventoried historic sites in Troutdale.
- 2. This concern centers on the implementing measures of the District which do not apply automatically to such sites even when these are affected by development or demolition proposals.
- 3. The changes as shown on the attached page, referred to as Exhibit "A", will resolve the aforementioned concern and are consistent with the City's revised Comprehensive Plan.
- 4. Exhibit "A" has been reviewed and recommended by the Troutdale Planning Commission.
- 5. Exhibit "A" is consistent with the remaining portions of the Zoning Ordinance text.
- 6. There has been opportunity for citizen review and comment.
- 7. The changes are in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

The Zoning Ordinance text be changed as shown in the attached Exhibit "A".
