

ORDINANCE NO. 420-0

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7.40 of TITLE 7 PUBLIC SAFETY CODE OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT Title 7 Public Safety Code, Chapter 7, that several sections be amended as follows:

7.40.075 is amended to read:

(C) Operate any vehicle of any type on the trails in Beaver Creek Canyon. No wheelchairs or baby carriages allowed on Beaver Creek Canyon trails due to safety hazard.

7.40.110 is amended to read:

Permit for group activities. A permit must be secured from the Director for any group activity consisting of more than fifty (50) persons.

7.40.130 is amended to read:

Interference with permittees prohibited. No person shall disturb or interfere unreasonably with any person or party occupying any area, or participating in any activity, under the authority of a permit.

7.40.140 is amended to read:

Prohibited games and activities. No person shall participate or assist others in the playing of any game or activity within which any object such as a stone, arrow, javelin, model airplane, golf ball, baseball or any other sharp or hard object or projectile is thrown or otherwise propelled except in areas specifically designed and designated for that use unless written permission therefore has been issued by the Director.

7.40.141 Areas of Limited Activities. No person shall participate in any prohibited activity in areas so specified and posted. The Director may designate areas of limited activity. Such areas shall be designated by posted notices which clearly define the activities prohibited. Such notices shall be posted in one or more places which are conspicuous to any person in the near vicinity of the designated area.


7.40.150 is amended to read:

Consumption of alcoholic beverages limited. No person shall bring into or consume alcoholic beverages in any park, provided, however, that the Director may designate certain parks or park areas where beer and wine in containers designed for individual consumption may be brought for use in meal preparation or consumption with meals.


