

ORDINANCE NO. 486-0

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 269, SECTION 3.10.080 OF THE ELECTION CODE.

WHEREAS, the present municipal election code provides in Section 3.10.080:

"The number of signatures on a petition requisite to its being duly prepared shall be, for an initiative petition, 15 percent, and for a referendum petition, 10 percent, of the number of votes cast for mayor at the regular election last preceding the deposit of the petition at the office of the recorder after its circulation;" and,

WHEREAS, ORS 250.305 requires that the proper measure be the percentage of voters registered in the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

Ordinance 369, section 3.10.080 of the Election Code be amended to read:


