

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW SECTION TO THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "DISORDERLY CONDUCT".

Definition -- Generally:

"Disorderly conduct" means a person commits the crime of disorderly conduct if, with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm or recklessly creating a risk thereof, he or she:

- (A) Engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior; or
- (B) Makes unreasonable noise; or
- (C) Disturbs any lawful assembly of persons without lawful authority; or
- (D) Obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic on a public way; or
- (E) Congregates with other persons in a public place and refuses to comply with a lawful order of the police to disperse; or
- (F) Initiates or circulates a report, knowing it to be false, concerning an alleged or impending fire, explosion, crime, catastrophe or other emergency; or
- (G) Creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act which he or she is not licensed or privileged to do.

Violation -- Penalty.

Class B misdemeanor.
