AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 215 RELATING TO STANDARD METER CHARGES FOR WATER USE, STANDARD MULTIPLE DWELLING CHARGES, FOR WATER USE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

ORDINANCE NO. 215 IS HEREBY AMENDED SO THAT THE WATER USE RATES EFFECTIVE PRIOR TO THE PASSAGE THEREOF ARE REINSTATED AS FOLLOWS:
