

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NO.S 215, 218 RELATING TO STANDARD METER CHARGES FOR WATER USE, STANDARD MULTIPLE DWELLING CHARGES, FOR WATER USE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

Now, therefore, Section 9, Water use rates of Ordinance 218 as amended by Ordinance 221 shall read as follows:

9. Water Use Rates:

9.1 Standard meter demand rates.

1"	16.00	18.00
1 1/2"	24.00	26.00

6"	104.00	106.00

9.2 Standard meter commodity charge

Bimonthly rates for all meters

0-9,000 gallons - included in minimum bi-monthly charge  
 next - 2,250 gallons - \$0.35 per 750 gallons  
 over - 11,250 gallons - \$0.25 per 750 gallons

9.3 Standby service connection demand charge


<u>Meter size</u>	<u>Minimum monthly charge</u>
4"	\$13.00
6"	16.00
8"	25.00
10"	33.00
12"	40.00
