

ORDINANCE NO. 575 -O

**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AMENDING
THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 8 HEALTH
AND SAFETY, CHAPTER 28 NUISANCES, SECTION .070,
SPECIFIC NUISANCES PROHIBITED, RELATING TO
CHANGING SUBSECTION 16 TO DELINEATE NUISANCE
CONDITIONS OF PLAY, SPORT OR ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT
WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale recognizes that not all right-of-ways are of equal size, classification, use or level of development, and

WHEREAS, dead-end streets and cul-de-sacs have less potential for carrying traffic, and

WHEREAS, dead-end streets and cul-de-sacs carry traffic at lower volumes and speeds than other city streets, and

WHEREAS, slower traffic at decreased volumes reduces the potential conflict between pedestrian and vehicular traffic

WHEREAS, there are numerous areas on dead-end and cul-de-sac streets where play, sport or athletic equipment may be located without creating a nuisance condition.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

The Troutdale Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


TMC 8.28.070

16. Any playground, sports or athletic equipment or structure placed within or immediately adjacent to a public right-of-way which, if used regularly, requires or encourages playground sports or athletic activity located:
 - a. within an area traveled by through vehicular traffic
 - b. within an area of clear vision area required by the Troutdale Development Code

- c. within any area where such activity causes an obstruction to traffic flow or a danger to the participant in the activity

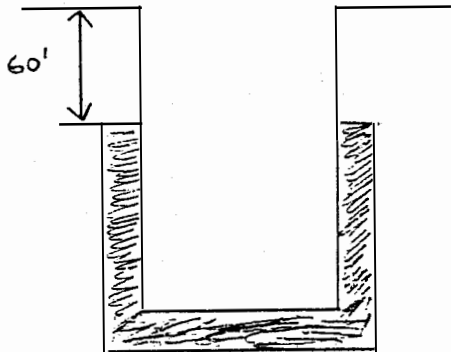
