

ORDINANCE NO. 581-O

**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AMENDING
THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 6, CHAPTER
6.04, DEFINITIONS, AND CHAPTER 6.12, LICENSING**

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the issue of permitting wild and dangerous animals within the city limits of Troutdale, and

WHEREAS, the Troutdale Municipal Code does not clearly define domestic animals, wild or dangerous animals or exotic animals, and

WHEREAS, modification of the TMC, Title 6, will bring more consistency with other jurisdictions in Multnomah County, and

WHEREAS, the process for issuance of facility licenses will be clarified, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing to consider adoption of these amendments was held on June 9, 1992, and

WHEREAS, licensing of individual wild or dangerous animals or licensing of facilities for this type of animal is not in the best interests of the citizens of Troutdale, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:**

The Troutdale Municipal Code, Title 6, be amended as follows:

6.04.040 Definitions:

Delete Definition "B" and replace with the following:

B. "Animal":

1. Domestic Animal - shall mean typical household pets such as dogs, cats, birds and fish.
2. Wild & Dangerous Animal - shall mean any breed of animal with a history of causing physical injury to a human being. Wild & Dangerous Animals shall include but not be limited to; any class 1, 2, or 3 feline (lions, tigers, jaguars, leopards, cougars, cheetahs, bobcats, etc.). bears, poisonous snakes,

wolves, wolf dog mixes, foxes, etc. No wild or dangerous animal of any kind may be allowed within the City of Troutdale.

3. Exotic Animals - shall mean non-domestic animals that are not classified as being wild or dangerous. Exotic animals shall be limited to animals which may be domesticated and shall include but not necessarily be limited to pigeons, peacocks, deer, pot bellied pigs, pheasants, etc. Exotic animals shall be subject to restrictions of "livestock" in the Troutdale Development Code.

6.12.025 Application of facilities, licensing, regulation and standards.

Add new Section B.


- B. Establishment of a wild & dangerous animal facility is prohibited within the city limits of Troutdale. No facility licenses or individual licenses shall be issued for any animal, as defined in Section 6.04.040 B. (2).

Renumber Section B. to "C"
