ORDINANCE NO.602-94-O

AN ORDINANCE NAMING A CITY STREET 257TH WAY

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 227.120 requires that renaming of streets be accomplished by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City has recently completed construction of a roadway from 257th Avenue to the City's Waste Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, businesses located in the Columbia Gorge Factory Stores have an address based on their proximity to 257th Avenue such that it would be beneficial to retain that designation; and

WHEREAS, Troutdale Municipal Code Section 12.05.070 designates streets running east and west off grid as "ways".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City street between 257th Avenue and the Waste Water Treatment Plant, as indicated on the attached map which is made a part hereof, is hereby named "257th Way".
