ORDINANCE NO. 647

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE EXTRA-TERRITORIAL EXTENSION OF PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES AND AMENDING SECTION 12.01.110 OF THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Section 12.01.110 of the Troutdale Municipal Code permits the City Council to extend public works services outside the corporate limits of the City in accordance with State law; and

WHEREAS, the relevant state law (ORS 199.464) prohibits a City from extending water or sewer lines extra-territorially without approval of a boundary commission; and

WHEREAS, Statewide Planning Goal 11 prohibits extension of sewer lines from within an urban growth boundary to land outside an urban growth boundary; and

WHEREAS, there is no state law compelling a City to extend services extra-territorially; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to conserve the remaining capacity of its public works services for use by lands within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does not want to remove any incentive for the future annexation of lands currently outside the City but within our urban planning area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That Section 12.01.110 of the Troutdale Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

12.01.110 Extension of service prohibited.

Public works services shall not be extra-territorially extended.
