

ORDINANCE NO. 719

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING THE CONDITIONAL
VACATION OF A PORTION OF NW GRAHAM CIRCLE AND
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 629**


THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


1. In June of 1995, following a request from Toyo Tanso USA Inc. and a favorable recommendation from the Planning Commission, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 629 to vacate a portion of NW Graham Circle subject to a number of conditions.
2. To date, the conditions necessary to effect the vacation of that portion of NW Graham Circle have not been met.
3. The City has received a letter dated April 3, 2002 from Toyo Tanso USA Inc. indicating that they had a change in plans and that their expansion would not go forward.
4. Since the conditional vacation of a portion of NW Graham Circle is no longer needed by Toyo Tanso USA Inc., its rescision is desirable so as to remove any doubt as to the status of this right-of-way.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TROUTDALE**

That Ordinance No. 629, an Ordinance Vacating a Portion of NW Graham Circle Abutting Lots 4, 5, 6, and 7, Troutdale Industrial Park, is repealed.
