

ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.12 OF THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARKING VEHICLES IN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

THE CITY COUNCIL FINDS:

1. Public safety requires that the traffic flow through the City without unintended or unregulated interruptions.
2. When vehicles are parked in public rights-of-way for the purpose of being offered for sale, the parked vehicles interrupt the flow of traffic and create hazards that compromise public safety.
3. It is necessary to prohibit parking vehicles, for the purpose of offering them for sale, in the public rights-of-way in the City.

Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 10.12.090 of the Troutdale Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.12.090 Parking – Prohibited when

No operator shall park and no owners shall allow a vehicle to be parked upon a street or public right of way for the principal purpose of:


- A. Repairing or servicing the vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.
- B. Displaying advertising from the vehicle.
- C. Selling merchandise from the vehicle.

D. Offering the vehicle for sale.
