ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.12 OF THE TROUTDALE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARKING VEHICLES IN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

THE CITY COUNCIL FINDS:

- 1. Public safety requires that the traffic flow through the City without unintended or unregulated interruptions.
- 2. When vehicles are parked in public rights-of-way for the purpose of being offered for sale, the parked vehicles interrupt the flow of traffic and create hazards that compromise public safety.
- 3. It is necessary to prohibit parking vehicles, for the purpose of offering them for sale, in the public rights-of-way in the City.

Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 10.12.090 of the Troutdale Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.12.090 Parking - Prohibited when

No operator shall park and no owners shall allow a vehicle to be parked upon a street or public right of way for the principal purpose of:

- A. Repairing or servicing the vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.
- B. Displaying advertising from the vehicle.
- C. Selling merchandise from the vehicle.

D. Offering the vehicle for sale.
