

ORDINANCE NO. 736

AN ORDINANCE NAMING A PUBLIC STREET NW GRAHAM CIRCLE

THE TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In 1991, the City accepted a dedication of Tracts A, C, and D in the plat of the "Troutdale Industrial Park, Lots 1 through 7" as recorded December 22, 1989 in Book 1220, Page 83, Multnomah County Records, as a public road.
2. The City named the new street NW Graham Circle on City maps and street signs, and the property owners have used that address since the development was completed. However, the City did not take the necessary step to formally name the street as required by ORS 227.120.
3. This Ordinance is a house-keeping measure intended to correct the oversight and officially designate the public street as NW Graham Circle.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

The public street designated as Tracts A, C, and D on the plat of the "Troutdale Industrial Park, Lots 1 through 7" in Section 23C, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian, Multnomah County, Oregon and as depicted on the attached map is named NW Graham Circle.



Tract C

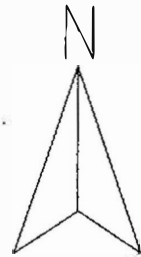
