

RESOLUTION NO. 110

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE LIMITED EMERGENCY CONCERNING THE TROUTDALE RAILWAY DEPOT AS A FIRE HAZARD AND THE ACTION NECESSARY TO REMOVE THE FIRE DANGER.

WHEREAS, the Troutdale Railway Depot has been moved close to its new destination, but is still on movingblocks; and,

WHEREAS, it is a target for vandalism and represents a fire danger as long as it is on blocks and unoccupied; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Contracts Bid Law requires informal bids for any contract between \$1,000 to \$5,000 unless an emergency exists and the City ordinance requires bids for any project over \$ 3,000;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL that the City staff is hereby directed to obtain the lowest possible excavation and foundation price within a reasonable period of time in order to locate the Depot in its new permanent location, ready for occupancy.

Adopted by the Common Council this 11th day of May, 1976.


