

RESOLUTION NO. 111

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY NEED FOR A NEW PRIMARY WATER SOURCE AND DEVELOPING THE EXISTING PRIMARY SOURCE AS A SECONDARY SOURCE, AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL,

WHEREAS, the existing primary water well known as the Drinker Well is capable of meeting the City's water needs only by pumping at a rate which causes aeration of the water source; and

WHEREAS, a larger diameter well would be capable of producing in excess of present needs and without the aeration; and

WHEREAS, at a lower rate of pumping the present primary well (Drinker) would continue to be a necessary and functional back-up or secondary water supply; therefore

SECTION 1. Drilling and development-that City staff is directed to begin siting and drilling for a new well; that the City staff is to develop the new well and transform the existing well into a secondary water source. That engineering and preliminary costs are to be paid out of the Enterprise Fund contingency account in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.


SECTION 2. Emergency Clause-the protection of the general public health and welfare, now therefore an emergency is declared and this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Common Council of the City this 11th day of May, 1976.


