

RESOLUTION NO. 115

A RESOLUTION TO ASSIGN SUFFICIENT FUNDS TO COVER MOVING, A FOUNDATION, LANDSCAPING, PROVIDING UTILITY SERVICES, DOORS, AND EXTERIOR REPAIRS OF TROUTDALE DEPOT BI-CENTENNIAL PROJECT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That the Troutdale Railroad Depot be the City of Troutdale's 1976 Bi-Centennial project.

That the reclamation of the historic Troutdale Depot be the City's volunteer program and a permanent tribute of the citizens of the community.

That the City Recorder use Park Land Purchase funds in the amount of \$15,500 budgeted in the 1975-76 Park Dept., STREET FUND for the purpose of moving, restoring, and establishing the Troutdale Railroad Depot as a museum, bus reststop and mini-park.

That the project be partially funded by Grant in the amount of \$2,500 from the American Revolution Bi-Centennial Commission of Oregon.

Adopted by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, Oregon this 22nd day of June, 1976.


