

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING NO PARKING AREAS ON THE SCENIC HIGHWAY IN THE EAST SECTION OF TROUTDALE.

Whereas, numerous trespass complaints from residents along the Columbia River Scenic Highway in the East side of Troutdale have been received by the City Council;

Whereas, the City staff and members of the State Highway Department have found the parking along the shoulder poses significant safety hazards; and

Whereas, Ordinance No. 226 authorizes the City Council to establish such parking controls as necessary to protect the health and welfare of the community; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF TROUTDALE, THAT

1. NO PARKING areas are hereby established along the Columbia River Scenic Highway in the East section of Troutdale, except in those areas established by the City staff and State Highway Department as posing no safety or trespass problem; and


2. that the State is authorized to post the necessary signs; the effect of this action will be in full force and effect as of this day upon the posting of the NO PARKING notices.
