

WHEREAS transportation is a regional concern and

WHEREAS the elected officials and professional staff of the east Multnomah County Cities have met and conferred about transportation needs in the East Multnomah County portion of the Portland Metropolitan region and

WHEREAS the Banfield Freeway is now presently under utilized in the East Multnomah County area due largely to the lack of North-South arterial routes connecting the Banfield Freeway with population centers and the Mt. Hood Highway and

WHEREAS substantial capital investments have been made in the East Multnomah County transportation system with the exception of North-South arterials and

WHEREAS 223rd Avenue presently has both the right-of-way and grade requirements appropriate to a major arterial

THEREFORE now be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale that the top transportation priority for the East Multnomah County area, as part of the Greater Portland Region, is the 223rd/Banfield Freeway interchange, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that improvements to 223rd Avenue, Burnside Street, and any other transportation system improvements be pursued after the construction of, or commitment to construct, the 223rd/Banfield Freeway Interchange.
