

RESOLUTION NO. 134

Whereas Multnomah County Commission meetings are held between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 5 P.M. in the Multnomah County Courthouse; and

Whereas Many interested and concerned citizens have difficulty attending these meetings due to job commitments and insufficient parking in the core area; and

Whereas Many units of local government located in Multnomah County such as school districts, special service districts and the cities of Maywood Park, Troutdale, Gresham, Wood Village, and Fairview hold evening meetings for the convenience of their citizens; and

Whereas Accessibility of citizens to their elected officials promotes good government; and

Whereas There is no provision in the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter to prevent commission meetings from being held at places other than the Multnomah County Court-House; and

Therefore be it resolved that

The regular meeting occurring in the second week of each month beginning in March 1977 should be held in the evening beginning at 7:30 P.M. The meeting is to be held in one of the five districts as provided in the charter amendment enacted by the voters at the November 2, 1976 general election. These meetings are to be held on a rotating basis in the districts so that each district shall have not less than two commission meetings each year; and be it further

Resolved That the recording secretary of the City of Troutdale be instructed to send a copy of this resolution to each of our Multnomah County Commissioners.


