RESOLUTION NO. 138

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 15, 1977, A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A TWO YEAR STREET LIGHTING TAX LEVY IN THE SUM OF \$34,500.00 PER YEAR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That the following proposition be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale at a special election to be held on March 15, 1977:

QUESTION: Shall a temporary two year serial levy tax of \$34,500.00 per year for fiscal year 1977-78 and fiscal year 1978-79 be authorized for the purpose of operating street lighting?

EXPLANATION: The City Council has referred this measure to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale. The City Council repealed the street light district fee effective July 1, 1977. After July 1, 1977 City funds will be insufficient to provide both street maintenance and street light operating costs unless this measure is approved. Passage of this measure will also provide funds to begin converting to more energy efficient lighting units.
