

CITY RESOLUTION FOR ANNEXATION
AND CONCURRENCE FOR TRIPLE MAJORITY

RESOLUTION NO. 142

A Resolution furthering annexation to the City of TROUTDALE of the territory described as follows:

A tract of land situated in Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Multnomah, and State of Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe 40 rods south of the southeast corner of the Addison C. Dunbar D.L.C.; running thence south 769.3 feet to a point; thence west 1119 feet, more or less, to the County Road; thence north along said County Road, 769 feet; thence east 1119 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, excepting the rights of the Public in and to any portion of said premises that may be included in any public road or highway.

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowners' statements of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, at a regular session held on the 12th day of April, 1977, that:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves the proposed annexation and requests the Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.

The foregoing Resolution adopted this 12th day of April, 1977.


