

RESOLUTION NO. 144

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE POSITION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE REGARDING THE APPEARANCE OR USE OF THE TROUTDALE POSTMARK

WHEREAS, for many years the Post Office located in the City of Troutdale has post marked all mail with a stamp containing the name Troutdale, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Common Council of the City of Troutdale that the use of the Troutdale postmark may be discontinued,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT

It is the position of the Common Council of the City of Troutdale representing the citizens and inhabitants thereof, that the postmark containing the name Troutdale should be used now and hereafter by the United States Post Office officials in the City of Troutdale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a copy of this Resolution be personally delivered to the Postmaster of Troutdale and that he or she be urged to employ the Troutdale postmark in accordance with the desires expressed by this Resolution.
