

RESOLUTION NO. 147

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JUNE 14, 1977, A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A ONE YEAR SPECIAL OPERATING LEVY IN THE SUM OF \$26,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That, the following proposition be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale at a special election to be held on June 14, 1977:

QUESTION: Shall a **SPECIAL** one year general fund operating levy of \$26,000.00 be authorized?

EXPLANATION: The City Council upon recommendation of the Budget Committee has referred this proposal to the legal voters of Troutdale. A special operating levy of \$26,000.00 is necessary to maintain a minimum level of city services. Revenues generated by this levy will be placed in **the General Fund, where such funds may be used to** provide 24 hour police protection. The Oregon constitution limits the City's tax base to increases at the rate of 6% per year regardless of increases in population within the City boundaries. As a result Troutdale **City** taxes per household have decreased during the past four years. If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1977-1978 will be \$26,705.00 greater than the operating budget financed in the preceding year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a notice be published in the Gresham Outlook on two separate occasions between May 25, 1977, and June 4, 1977, giving notice that an election shall be held on June 14, 1977, to submit the aforesaid proposition to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for their approval or disapproval.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Multnomah County Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission be requested to waive the 55 day notice that the City Administrator be directed to request a hearing before the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission at the earliest possible date.
