

RESOLUTION NO. 148

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JUNE 14, 1977, A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A TWO YEAR TAX LEVY FOR ARTERIAL STREET LIGHTING PURPOSES IN THE SUM OF \$9,000.00 PER YEAR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE

That, a proposition, in substantially the following form, be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale at a special election to be held on June 14, 1977:

QUESTION: Shall a two year tax levy in the sum of \$9,000.00 per year for the purpose of arterial street lighting and conversion to more efficient lighting units be authorized?

EXPLANATION: The City Council has referred this proposal to the legal voters of Troutdale. This tax levy, if passed, will provide funds to pay street light energy costs necessary to light main thoroughfares or arterial streets where the greatest traffic or other hazards exist. Also, some funds will be used to replace existing lamps with more efficient lamps for the purpose of reducing future energy costs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT a notice be published in the Gresham Outlook on two separate occasions between May 25, 1977, and June 4, 1977, giving notice that an election shall be held on June 14, 1977, to submit the aforesaid proposition to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for their approval or disapproval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Multnomah County Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission be requested to waive the 55 day notice that the City Administrator be directed to request a hearing before the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission at the earliest possible date.
