

RESOLUTION NO. 155

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THE CITY OF PORTLAND AND THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING AND OPERATING AN EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS/OPERATIONS CENTER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. The City of Troutdale is hereby authorized to enter into an inter-governmental agreement with the City of Portland and the County of Multnomah for the operation and joint use of an Emergency Communications/Operations Center and that such agreement shall be substantially the same form as the agreement attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.


2. The aforesaid agreement may be executed by the Mayor of the City of Troutdale.



AGREEMENT FOR
EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

The CITY OF PORTLAND, OREGON (Portland) and the CITY OF TROUTDALE, OREGON (Troutdale) agree as follows:

RECITALS

1. The City of Portland, Oregon and Multnomah County, Oregon entered into an agreement, dated December 5, 1974, which was amended by "Amending Agreement" executed September 4, 1975. These agreements established a combined City-County emergency call receiving, dispatch and operations center at Kelly Butte and provide for participation of that system by other agencies. Said agreement and amending agreement were amended by an "Amendatory Agreement" between Portland and Multnomah County, September 19, 1976, which amended the section entitled "Budget and Fiscal Control."
2. Troutdale desires to participate in the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, parties agree as follows:

1. Troutdale agrees to be a participant in the communications system established by Portland and County by agreements dated September 4, 1975 and December 15, 1974. As a participant, Troutdale will comply with and keep all the rules and principles established for operation of the center.
2. Troutdale agrees to make quarterly payments to the City of Portland in accordance with the system established by "Budget and Fiscal Control" for County participation. Reimbursement to the City shall be based upon an annual percentage allocation of radio volume by user agency multiplied times the final year-end costs documented by the Financial Management System. Troutdale will not assign operators to the Center.
