

RESOLUTION NO. 160

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING PETITIONS FROM HOME OWNERS REQUESTING PERMISSION TO PAY FOR THE COSTS AND TO CONTRACT WITH PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC THROUGH THE CITY OF TROUTDALE FOR NEIGHBORHOOD STREET LIGHTING.

Whereas the maximum costs of street lighting are known to the petitioners, and

Whereas the petitioners have agreed to pre-pay the six month costs, and

Whereas, the City Administrator recommends Council approval as the districts have reasonable boundaries and represent a substantial majority of the residents, now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:


1. The Neighborhood Street Light "Mini-Districts" as submitted by petitions and summarized as attachment "A" to this document are now formed, and that
2. The City Administrator is to prepare a final cost share for each district when the State Public Utility Commissioner makes a final decision on rates, and that
3. The City Administrator is to send out the billings for services, and that
4. The City Administrator is to immediately notify Portland General Electric to avoid any interruption of service or turn-offs in those areas for which districts are now formed by the Council.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, this 13th day of September, 1977.


