

RESOLUTION NO. 162

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL ALTERNATIVE FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE SEWERAGE TREATMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale, Oregon is in the process of developing a 201 facility planning report for the expansion of their sewerage treatment system, and;

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the "Preliminary Screening of Alternatives," the "Detailed Development and Analysis of Selected Alternatives," and has held a public hearing on the proposed project, and;

WHEREAS, no adverse testimony has been received with respect to any of the features of this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. It has been determined from the reports presented to the Council that of all the alternatives presented, the alternative to expand the existing sewage treatment plant at its present location with summer discharge to land disposal is:

- A. The most environmentally acceptable.
- B. Reasonably protective of the surface waters of the state.
- C. Provides beneficial use to a local farming operation.
- D. Appears to meet the intent of best practicable waste treatment technology required by Federal legislation.

Section 2. The alternative to land dispose of treatment plant effluent is hereby selected as the plan to be implemented for summer-time effluent disposal of the expanded sewerage treatment system.
