

RESOLUTION 163

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE WELL #2 PUMP HOUSE FROM PUBLIC CONTRACT REVIEW PROVISIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, a Call-for-Bids was made in accordance with State Law and City Ordinance, and

Whereas, only one bid was received and that bid was rejected as being substantially beyond the Engineer's estimate, and

Whereas, the Common Council as the Local Public Contracts Review Board finds that the lack of bids will not result in any favoritism, and that the Board finds that the potential for freezing weather damage to the City's main water source would be costly to repair and would create a public health emergency now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT,


1. An exemption to the public contracts requirement is declared and that an emergency is found to exist.
2. The City Administrator and City Engineer are to enter into direct negotiations with qualified and interested parties for the purpose of constructing Well #2 Pump house, and that the Mayor is duly authorized to sign on behalf of the City and the Council as Contract Review Board to implement such an agreement in an amount of \$21,500 or less.


