

RESOLUTION NO. 164

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council that Multnomah County Oregon, by its commissions, entered on order dated September 8, 1977 offering to surrender jurisdiction to the City over a portion of S. E. Sandy Street, all of S. E. Third street, and a portion of S. E. Dora Street, more fully hereinafter described, and being wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Troutdale, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, no awards of damages and no assessment of benefits have been sustained by anyone, and it appearing to the Council that all of said County road should be laid out, taken over and established as a city street,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, Oregon that the above said streets, more particularly described as follows, to wit:

All that portion of S. E. Sandy Street, including any portion of which may have been known as Troutdale Road, from the Section Line common to Sections 25 and 36, TIN, R3E, W. M., northerly to its intersection with S.E. 3rd Avenue, formerly known as Garfield Street, which is 60.00 feet in width as it was dedicated by the deed recorded April 18, 1898, in Book 249, Page 261, in the Deed Records of Multnomah County, Oregon;

All of S. E. 3rd Street, formerly known as Garfield Street, from S. E. Sandy Street westerly to Buxton Road, County Road No. 342, formerly known as Willamette Street, which is 60.00 feet in width as it was dedicated by the plat of "Map of Troutdale", recorded February 27, 1890 in Book 140, page 91 in the Plat records of Multnomah County, Oregon; also

All that portion of S. E. Dora Street, from S. E. 3rd Street, formerly known as Garfield Street northerly to S. E. Columbia Street, also known as S. E. Sandy Boulevard, formerly County Road No. 917, and formerly known as the Columbia River Highway, which is 60.00 feet in width as it was dedicated by the above mentioned plat of "Map of Troutdale;

shall be hereby taken over, laid out and established as a City Street; and it is,

FURTHER RESOLVED that from this date forward the jurisdiction of said County of Multnomah over said streets for their improvement, construction and repair shall cease, and determine, and the full and absolute jurisdiction over the same for all purposes of improvement, construction and repair, and the levying and collecting of assessments therefore shall vest in the City of Troutdale, and the City of Troutdale shall have the same control, power and jurisdiction over the same as by its charter and laws of the State given or granted it over any of the public streets and alleys of said cities, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder forward copies of this resolution to the County Commissioners of Multnomah County, the County Roadmaster and the County Assesor.


