WHEREAS, the Committee has proposed a balanced and financially feasible program meeting the current needs in the areas, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT the following projects as proposed by the Committee are supported by the City of Troutdale for use of the transfer funds:

1. Cherry Park Road Realignment and Improvements
2. Buxton-Troutdale-Cherry Park Roads Intersection
3. Fairview Avenue Signalization
4. 221 st Avenue Extension
5. 182nd Avenue Widening and Storm Drain
6. 238th Avenue Widening
7. Hogan Road Widening




