

RESOLUTION No. 167

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A SECOND POLLING PLACE IN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AND REQUESTING THE SAME FROM THE DIRECTOR OF ELECTIONS, MULTNOMAH COUNTY.

Whereas, Troutdale City Hall presently serves three large precincts, and is not convenient for the Sweetbriar precinct, and,

Whereas, Sweetbriar School is available and convenient to over half of the electorate of the City of Troutdale, and

Whereas, the rapidly growing City areas are closer to Sweetbriar School and City Hall, and,

Whereas, long lines existed at the last general election, and the city's population was only 2500 but will be 4000 by the next general election, now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT,


1. A Polling place at Sweetbriar School should be established by Multnomah County in addition to the place at City Hall, and that,
2. This should be as soon as possible and definitely by November of 1978.


