

RESOLUTION NO. 170

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 14, 1978, A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A FOUR-YEAR NEIGHBORHOOD STREET LIGHTING TAX LEVY IN THE SUM OF \$32,000 PER YEAR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE,

That the following proposition be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale at a special election to be held on March 14, 1978:

QUESTION: Shall a temporary four-year serial levy tax of \$32,000 per year for fiscal years 1978-79, 1979-80, 1980-81 and 1981-82 be authorized for the purpose of operating neighborhood street lighting?


EXPLANATION: The City Council with the recommendation of the Citizen's Street Lighting Task Force has referred this measure to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale. City funds are not sufficient to provide street light operatings costs unless this measure is approved. The other alternative financing plans of Petition Districts or Special Districts are more costly per household than the recommended serial levy.
