

RESOLUTION NO. 172

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO MASS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS SERVING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, AND STATING THE POLICY OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, a large segment of our population relies solely upon public mass transit; and

WHEREAS, an even larger and rapidly growing segment of our population could use a properly designed public mass transit system;

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale and its residents and property owners pay taxes towards the support of these systems; now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, THAT:

1. the City supports the efforts of Metro-Mobility, the East Multnomah County Rural Service Delivery Agency, to increase its shuttle service to the residents of Troutdale and adjacent areas in order to facilitate transportation within the immediate area and to provide better connection with the Tri-Met system; and
2. the City opposes the reduction in services to the City of Troutdale by Tri-Met. And that the City suggests that a properly designated loop linking Fairview, Wood Village, Mount Hood Community College, the Sweetbriar Community and the Downtown Community of Troutdale, all with express services into and from Lloyd Center and Downtown ought to be conducted as a feasible way to encourage ridership and to then evaluate operations costs.
3. the City of Troutdale favors a coordinated effort to encourage and develop, rather than to restrict and decrease, public mass transit systems.


