

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of water lines and sewer lines to serve an area of the City of Troutdale north of the Interstate Freeway I-5 in the general vicinity of the Portland-Troutdale Airport, said water and sewer lines to be connected to the existing city systems near the intersection of the freeway and Graham Road.

The improvements are to be finance by individual assessments against benefited properties.

The engineer's report has been accepted and reviewed by the City Council and hereby is approved and is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The City Council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvements by any parties aggrieved thereby at the regular meeting of the Council at 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 13, 1978, at The City Hall, 104 S.E. Kibling Street.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and/or publishing at least 10 days prior to the hearing.
