

RESOLUTION NO. 219

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE PLANNING AREAS FOR THE CITIES OF WOOD VILLAGE, FAIRVIEW AND TROUTDALE.

WHEREAS the Cities of Wood Village, Fairview and Troutdale are all entering into an "Urban Planning Area Agreement" with Multnomah County, and

WHEREAS coordination of these separate agreements among the three cities may eliminate unnecessary and cumbersome procedural requirements, and

WHEREAS each city recognized that there is no need for an overlap of planning areas, and

WHEREAS each city has reviewed a map of each of the other two cities' proposed planning areas, attached hereto as Exhibit 'A',


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Troutdale that the City supports the urban planning areas, as shown on Exhibit 'A', for the three cities, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Troutdale agrees to notify the Cities of Wood Village and Fairview of any change in its planning area which would affect those cities.


