WHEREAS, on Saturday night, January 27, 1979, a boating accident occurred on a portion of the Sandy River in Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, James McCarthy, an 8 year old boy from Lake Oswego, was involved in said boating accident; and

WHEREAS, upon hearing the cries for help from James McCarthy, said LANE DeSMET entered into the cold, dark River and rescued the youth and is, therefore, credited with saving the life of James McCarthy.


