

RESOLUTION NO. 229

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TROUTDALE TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION WARRANTS.

WHEREAS, a local improvement district known as LID 3-78, Halsey Storm Sewer will be under construction in the near future, and

WHEREAS, the Bancroft Bonding Act allows the City to issue general obligation improvement warrants to interimly finance local improvements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT,

1. The City Recorder is hereby authorized to issue general obligation improvement warrants bearing interest from the date of issuance to the time when called for payment at a rate not to exceed 6.5% per annum net effective interest rate. All warrants shall mature on or before two years after the date thereof. All warrants shall be limited to general obligations of the City of Troutdale such that if repayment is not made by unbonded assessment payments, sale of bonds or lien foreclosures, the repayments may be made from taxes levied within the tax base, plus constitutional annual increases.

2. The Finance Director shall establish a limited general obligation warrant sinking fund into which shall be placed the proceeds of all unbonded assessment payments, sale of bonds, lien foreclosures and taxes levied for this purpose.

3. All proceeds from the collection of unbonded assessments, the sale of improvement bonds, taxes, the foreclosure of improvement liens and unbonded assessments, realized from the improvement with respect to which such general obligation improvement warrants are issued, shall be applied to the call and payment of such warrants as rapidly as funds are available for the payment of the earliest outstanding warrant or warrants, but that call may be deferred in the discretion of the finance director when the funds available for the payment of outstanding warrants do not exceed \$2,500.00.

4. The warrants shall be called for payment by notice of intention to redeem the warrants given not less than five days nor more than thirty days prior to the call date by both:

(a) Publication of the notice in the Gresham Outlook, a newspaper of general circulation within Multnomah County, and

(b) Notice in writing directed to the holder of such warrants and mailed by ordinary mail concurrently with such publication, if the finance director has been informed of the name and address of such holder.

5. The warrants issued shall be in a form substantially as set forth in Exhibit "A", a copy of which is attached hereto, and made a part hereof by this reference.

6. The sum of all warrants issued pursuant to this resolution shall not exceed the contract amount for construction of LID 3-78.

THIS WARRANT SHALL BE PAYABLE FROM THE APPROPRIATE IMPROVEMENT FUND, OR, IF INSUFFICIENT, FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY. THIS WARRANT IS A GENERAL OBLIGATION OF THE CITY AND SHALL MATURE ON OR BEFORE TWO (2) YEARS FROM DATE HEREOF AND SHALL BE CALLABLE AT ANY TIME WITHIN SAID TERM.

IT IS CERTIFIED THAT ALL ACTS, CONDITIONS AND THINGS REQUIRED TO BE DONE PRECEDENT TO AND IN THE ISSUANCE OF THIS WARRANT HAVE BEEN PROPERLY DONE AND THAT THIS WARRANT IS A LEGALLY BINDING GENERAL OBLIGATION OF THE CITY.
