

RESOLUTION NO. 234

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 3, 1979, A PROPOSITION TO ESTABLISH A THREE YEAR TAX LEVY FOR ARTERIAL STREET LIGHTING PURPOSES IN THE SUM OF \$15,000 PER YEAR.

BACKGROUND: The two year arterial street lighting levy expires on June 30, 1979.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

1. Call for Election: An election is hereby called to be held on Tuesday, April 3, 1979, from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Pacific Standard Time) at which time a measure shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Troutdale which, if approved, would authorize a three year tax levy in the sum of \$15,000.00 per year for the purpose of arterial street lighting.
2. Referral of Proposition: The following measure is hereby referred to the voters:

#52 ARTERIAL STREET LIGHTING LEVY

PURPOSE: The purpose of this measure is to maintain street lighting on thoroughfares and arterial streets.

EXPLANATION: The City Council has referred this measure to the legal voters of Troutdale upon the recommendation of the Citizen's Street Light Task Force. The total amount to be raised by this levy is \$45,000.00 at \$15,000.00 per year. This tax levy, if passed, will provide funds to pay street light costs necessary to light main thoroughfares or arterial streets where the greatest traffic or other hazards exist. If this measure fails, street lighting along major roads will be turned off, since other sources of funds such as the State Gas Tax Street Fund are insufficient to pay for both street maintenance and street lighting. This levy replaces the existing two year arterial street lighting levy which expires June 30, 1979.

QUESTION: Shall a three year levy in the sum of \$15,000.00 per year for the purpose of arterial street lighting be authorized?

NO, against the arterial lighting levy _____

3. Directive to City Recorder: The City Recorder shall cause a notice to be published in the Gresham Outlook in not fewer than two consecutive issues between March 15, 1979, and March 23, 1979, inclusive, giving notice that an election shall be held on April 3, 1979, to submit the aforesaid proposition to the legal voters of the City of Troutdale for the approval or disapproval. The notice shall state that the polls shall be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and it shall state the location of polling places corresponding to each precinct within the city. The City Recorder is further authorized to appoint

or cause to be appointed election clerks and judges necessary for the conduct of the election. The full text of the aforesaid measure shall appear in the notice.
